Anniversary Appeal. Give thanks for the generous supporters hosting tea parties & pray for more hosts to come forward. www.globalcare.org/big-tea-parties

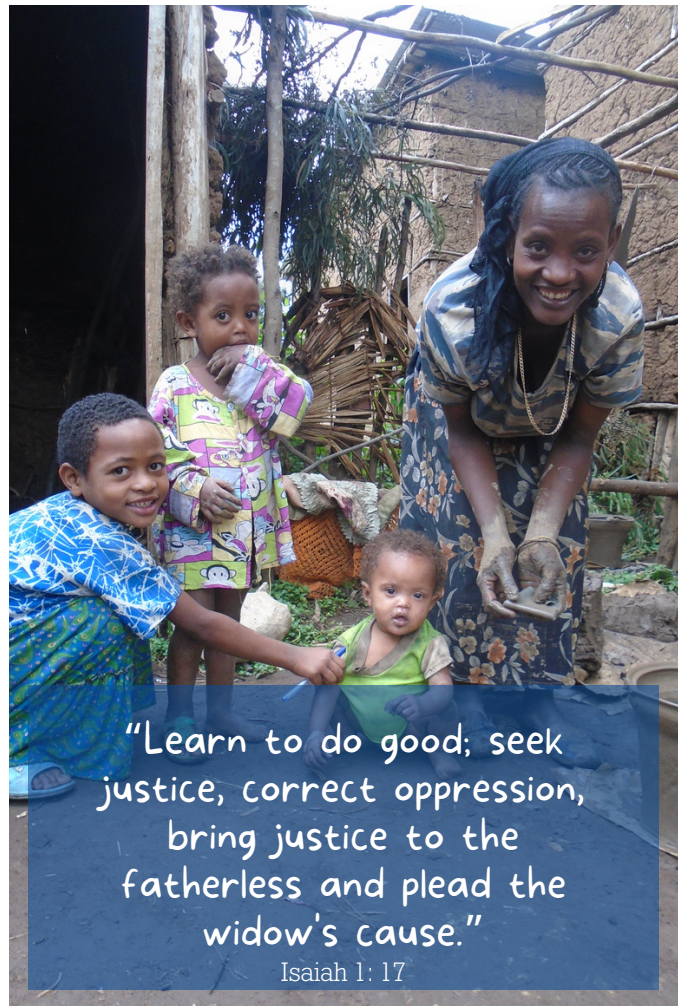
