seeking safety in Abeyei town. We're funding three months of emergency food and shelter, for 60 families (650 people). More info at www.globalcare.org/South-Sudan

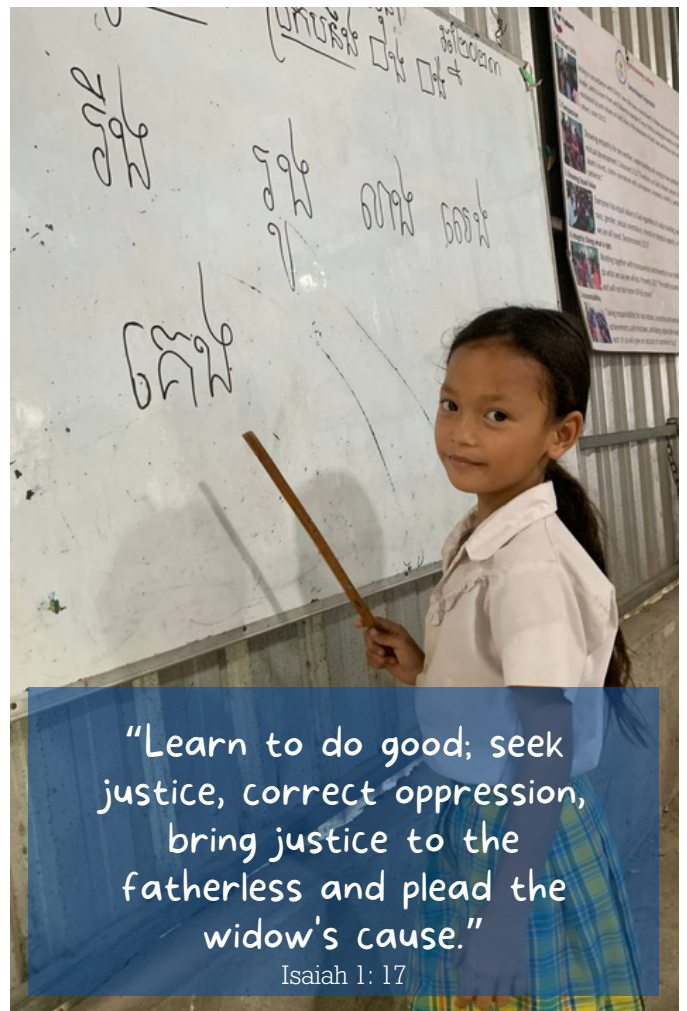
