forced to leave at 18, due to social services safeguarding rules, but an abrupt move to independence can derail the progress they have made. Find out more at globalcare.org/Lent-2026

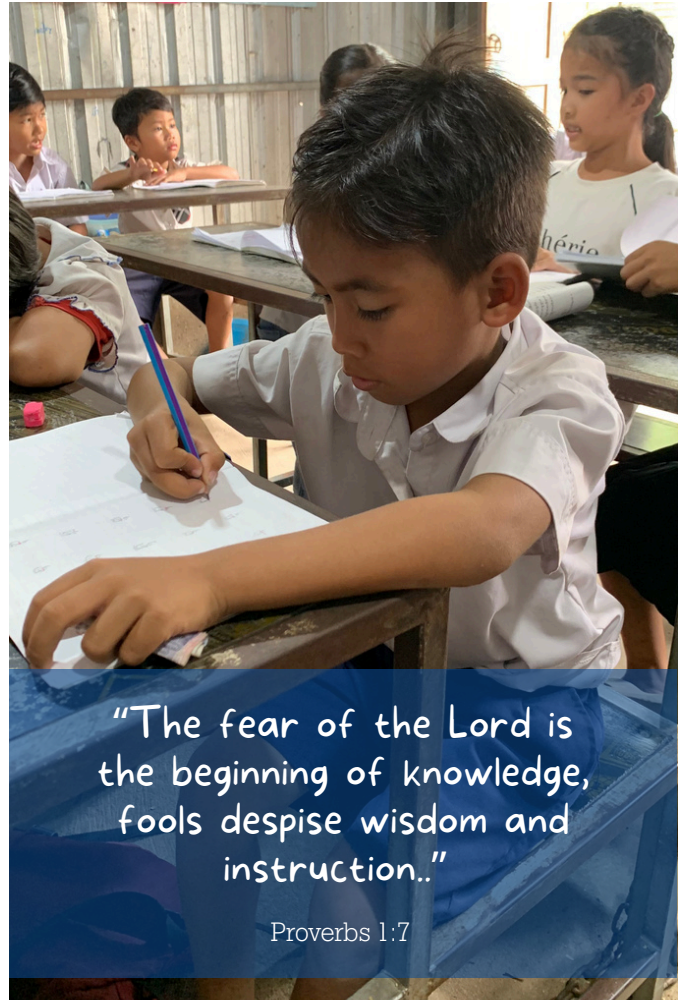

A Home for Lenny

18-year-old *Lenny has lived at HCC for more than ten years. Memories of life before HCC are fading, but he remembers the scarcity of food and clothing, and a long trek to fetch

water every day. At HCC he celebrates three meals a day, friends, security and a stable place to learn. Lenny recently completed a carpentry course and will be one of the first residents of the proposed new transitional home for boys who have aged out of statutory care at HCC, to be funded by our Lent Appeal.
