Lives torn apart

Life was already challenging for *Ayak, but a brutal attack ripped apart everything her family had. Ethnic violence still rumbles across South Sudan, and 12-year-old Ayak's family were among thousands of people most recently affected. They fled to Agok, where our partners work, with nothing - no spare clothes, no food, no shelter. Our local partners stepped up to provide what Ayak needed: Food, clothing, mosquito nets, mats and plastic sheeting to create a safer shelter. Thank God for the donor who made this possible for 1,250 people like Ayak.



WEEK FOUR

This week we are praying for our partners at the Kadella Centre, one of Sri Lanka's only support services for people living with HIV/AIDS.
